Quiz Instructions

New information is learned best when a student can connect the concepts to a personal memory or experience. Presenting new information in multiple formats can help reinforce the learning process and create new experiences for the learner to connect to and draw from.

Take the next 5 minutes to brainstorm hands-on activities or games that reinforce your lesson.

You can adapt an existing game/activity or create a new one. The activity should directly relate to the main takeaways from your lesson. The goal is to engage learners in a different and interactive way to create new experiences and memories to help reinforce the newly learned information.

Examples could include a drawing exercise, game with specific outcome, building or assembling equipment, peer discussions, acting or role playing.
